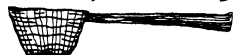

As we close out our 200th Birthday celebration, St. Joseph will "bite the bullet" and update our air cooling and heating system. There are now technologies on the market that could prove more energy-efficient and cost-effective. Additionally, the new system will include a central heat which will replace our boiler. Presently, we have to heat up the water in the reservoir over a couple of days and then start pumping heat into the Co-Cathedral. Once updated, we will be able to switch from air conditioning to the heating with the flip of a switch.
